Summary

This collection consists of the records of Elizabeth Drye from her time in the Domestic Policy Council. Drye was Chief of Staff from February 1996 to August 1997. This series highlights topics relating to tobacco, human radiation experiments, FDA reform, health care, cloning, food safety, pesticides, and transportation issues including blood alcohol levels, seatbelts, airbags, and aggressive drivers. The records include memoranda, faxes, reports, emails, news articles, Elizabeth Drye's handwritten notes, Chief of Staff meeting agendas, monthly calendars of the President and Vice President, and First Lady's schedules. The collection also contains correspondence addressed to the President, Carol Rasco, Bruce Reed, and Elizabeth Drye from Congress, state Attorneys General, the Department of Justice, the Food and Drug Administration, the Department of Agriculture, and various other federal agencies.

Scope and Content Note

Within the Domestic Policy Council, Elizabeth Drye was Chief of Staff from February 1996 to August 1997. In her position, Drye helped manage the President's domestic policy staff and advised on public health issues. She assisted Carol Rasco, Assistant to the President for Domestic Policy, by performing administrative tasks. Drye worked on topics relating to the Food and Drug Administration, the Advisory Committee on Human Radiation Experiments, tobacco litigation and legislation, and public health issues. After leaving the White House, Drye enrolled as a medical student at Harvard Medical School and graduated with her Doctor of Medicine in 2002. She went on to become the Director of Quality Measurement Programs at the Yale/Yale-New Haven Hospital Center for Outcomes Research and Evaluation (CORE) and a Research Scientist at Yale University School of Medicine. Before her work at

the White House, Elizabeth Drye served as U.S. Senator Joe Lieberman's Legislative Assistant for Health Care, Welfare, and Education. Prior to that position, she was Special Assistant to the Assistant Administrator for Policy, Planning, and Evaluation at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Drye holds a M.D. from Harvard Medical School, a M.S. in Health Policy and Management from the Harvard School of Public Health and a B.A. in Human Biology from Stanford University. This series highlights topics relating to tobacco, human radiation experiments, FDA reform, health care, cloning, food safety, pesticides, and transportation issues including blood alcohol levels, seatbelts, airbags, and aggressive drivers. This series contains drafts of the Advisory Committee on Human Radiation Experiments' report to the President as well as memorandum and correspondence from interested parties and federal agencies discussing the committee's findings and recommendations. This series also contains records relating to the tobacco litigation of states and the federal government including correspondence and memoranda between Domestic Policy Council staffers, Congress, state Attorneys General, the Department of Justice, and other federal agencies. The records include memorandum, faxes, reports, emails, news articles, handwritten notes by Elizabeth Drye, Chief of Staff meeting agendas, monthly calendars of the President, Vice President, and First Lady's schedules, and correspondence addressed to the President, Carol Rasco, Bruce Reed, and Elizabeth Drye from Congress, state Attorneys General, the Department of Justice, the Food and Drug Administration, the Department of Agriculture, and various other federal agencies.
