Summary

This collection consists of records related to the First Lady's youngest brother Tony Rodham. It contains correspondence concerning the May 28, 1994 White House wedding of Mr. Rodham and Nicole Boxer, yearly birthday greetings from the President, and photographs of the President and Tony Rodham playing golf. The collections also includes email correspondence concerning travel arrangements, planning preparations for the White House wedding, other event arrangements, speeches, interviews, briefings mentioning Mr. Rodham, and several emails concerning golf outings with the President.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2015-0523-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of a Freedom of Information Act request. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. Anthony Dean "Tony" Rodham is the youngest brother of First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton. Records responsive to this FOIA include correspondence concerning the wedding of Tony Rodham to Nicole Boxer held at the White House on May 28, 1994; yearly birthday greetings from the President to his brother-in-law; and photographs of the President and Tony Rodham playing Golf. The email in this collection consist of travel arrangements; a few planning preparations for his White House wedding; event arrangements; speeches, interviews, and briefings in which Mr. Rodham was mentioned; requests for White House staff to contact him, and several emails concerning golf outings with the President.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas - Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files CF, Clinton Presidential Records: Automated Records Management System [Email] and Clinton Presidential Records: Tape Restoration Project [Email]. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. WHORM files are processed at the document level. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The ARMS dataset is comprised of 6 sub-series of email records called "Buckets." The buckets include NPR, OPD, POTUS, WHO, CEA, and Default. ARMS emails are arranged chronologically by creation date. The Tape Restoration Project (TRP) is a database consisting of restored emails from the Automated Records Management System from July 1994 through June of 2000. The TRP is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential record email. The TRP dataset is comprised of 6 sub-series of email records called "Buckets." The buckets include NPR, OPD, POTUS, WHO, CEA, and Default. ARMS emails are arranged chronologically by creation date. FOIA 2015-0523-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: FE010-01 Federal Government, Ceremonials - Protocol FG006-01 Federal Government - Organizations, White House Office GI001 Gifts from the President ME001-02 Messages, Birthday greetings PE002 Personnel Management, Employment - Appointments PP005 Presidential (personal), Family, Presidential PP010-02 Presidential (personal), Condolence - Sympathy, Message received by the President PR005-01 Public Relations, Photographs granted, Presidential.

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended)

and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
