Summary

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2006-1135-F (Segment 82) is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created from September 13, 1993 & September 21, 1993 through September 23, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. Photographs from September 13, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in a photo-op with Vice President Gore, Tipper Gore, former Presidents George H.W. Bush, Jimmy Carter, Gerald Ford, and former First Ladies Rosalyn Carter and Betty Ford. Present include Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Gore, Tipper Gore, Leon Panetta, Donna Shalala, Speaker of the House Tom Foley, Senator George Mitchell, Senator Tom Daschle, Senator Steny Hoyer, Representative Henry Waxman, Representative Richard Gephardt, Senator Robert Dole, Senator John Breaux, Senator David Pryor, Representative Barbara Kennelly, Representative Dan Rostenkowski, Senator Ted Kennedy, and Senator David Durenberger. Photographs from September 23, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton participates in a morning jogging session with David Leopoulos in Washington, DC President Clinton greets Rollie Boreham in the Oval Office at the White House Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in various television morning show interviews at the White House. The interviews include CBS' "This Morning" with Paula Zahn in the Map Room, ABC's "Good Morning America" with Joan Lunden in the Old Family Dining Room, NBC's "Today Show" with Katie Couric in the Diplomatic Reception Room, and CNN's Judy Woodruff in the Library President Clinton greets Dawn Steele, John Emerson and Nancy Herrrich in the Oval Office at the White House President Clinton greets Kelly Crawford, Andrew Friendly and Betty Currie in the Outer Oval Office at the White House Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Senator John Breaux and Representative Jim Cooper in the West Wing at the White House President Clinton and Vice President Gore meet with automotive industry executives in the Oval Office. Participants include Ford Motor Company Chief Executive Officer

Harold Poling, General Motors Chief Executive Officer Jack Smith, and Chrysler Corporation Chief Executive Officer Bob Eaton President Clinton meets with former Chrysler Corporation Chief Executive Officer Lee Iacocca in the Oval Office at the White House President Clinton greets Teddy Kollek, the mayor of Jerusalem, Israel. Present are Tony Lake and Martin Indyk President Clinton and Vice President Gore meet with Democratic National Committee chairman David Wilhelm, national finance chairman Roy Furman, Roy Neel, and Joan Baggett President Clinton and Vice President Gore greet Willie Nelson in the Oval Office at the White House President Clinton greets National Service staffers in the Oval Office at the White House President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton greet visitors from Arkansas in the Oval Office and Outer Oval Office at the White House. President Clinton confers with White House staffers in the Oval Office Dining Room at the White House prior to the health care rally President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Gore, and Tipper Gore participate in a health care rally on the South Lawn at the White House. President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton greet the participating health care Chief Executive Officers in the Blue Room.
