Summary

This collection consists of records related to a 1993 request from District of Columbia Mayor Sharon Pratt Kelly to President Clinton about using the DC National Guard to augment the District's Police Forces in the city. The collection contains memos regarding the legal issues surrounding the request, correspondence from Representative Eleanor Holmes Norton and other leaders in the District of Columbia, copies of the original request from Mayor Kelly, copies of legislation and various press clippings regarding the District of Columbia National Guard.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2008-0264-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. The records in this collection relate to a 1993 request by former Washington D.C. Mayor Sharon Pratt Kelly. Mayor Kelly requested the President's support to amend or change Executive Order 11485, which gives authority over the D.C. National Guard to the President of the United States. Mayor Kelly wanted to use the National Guard to increase support for drug interdiction activities, to conduct roadblocks, and to augment the local police force. Mayor Kelly was also pursuing legislation in Congress that would change the command of the District's National Guard. The records in this collection include memos regarding the legal issues surrounding this request, correspondence from Representative Eleanor Holmes Norton and other leaders in the District of Columbia, copies of the original request from Mayor Kelly, copies of legislation and various news clippings regarding the National Guard.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas - Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM), Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM (CL), and Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files,. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993-1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM, WHORM Counsel, WHORM (CL), WHORM (OP), WHORM (Too Late); WHORM (Various Offices); and WHORM (Alpha Project) series. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. WHORM files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing, While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. Access

and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
