Summary

This collection consists of records on the Jamaat ul-Fuqra organization. Founded in 1980 , while not a designated terrorist group, they are described as a paramilitary group based in the United States and Pakistan.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2016-0572-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Although not designated a terrorist group, Jamaat ul-Fuqra has been described as a paramilitary organization composed mostly of African-American Muslims based in the United States and Pakistan. Since the group's founding in 1980, members have been linked to a number of violent incidents in the U.S. and Canada. This collection consists primarily of cables on Jamaat ul-Fuqra linked incidents. Also included is correspondence from an American Muslim organization and NSC Records Management System cover sheets.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas: Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alpha Files; Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office

Files; and Clinton Presidential Records: NSC Cable, Email, and Records Management System. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993-1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. WHORM files are processed at the document level.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
