## **Summary**

This collection consists of records related to the film High Noon. The High Noon is an American Western film that released in 1952. The film earned an estimated \$3.4 million at the North American box office. The collection contains interview transcripts with President Clinton from People Magazine and Katie Couric of NBC. The files also include correspondence, drafts, notes, invitations and internet articles. The correspondence, drafts and notes consist of thank you letters from the President to individuals thanking them for sending him copies of the film.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2016-1092-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The records contain interview transcripts with President Clinton from People Magazine and Katie Couric of NBC. They also contain correspondence, drafts, notes, invitations and articles from the internet. The correspondence, drafts and notes contain thank you letters from the President to individuals thanking them for sending him copies of the movie, High Noon.

## **Biographical Note**

The movie High Noon is an American Western film that was released in 1952. High Noon was nominated for 7 Academy Awards and won four. The film also won four Golden Globe Awards and in 1989 the Library of Congress selected High Noon for preservation in the United States National Film Registry as being “culturally, historically, or aesthetically significant”. President Clinton, in several interviews says

that High Noon is one of his all-time favorite movies. In an interview with People Magazine he said, “best western ever made” and when Katie Couric of NBC interviewed him he told her all about the movie and why he liked it so much.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) (OP) and Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM (OP) series. WHORM files are processed at the document level; that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. FOIA 2016-1092-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: FG001-07 Federal Government: Appointments Granted, Presidential GI002 Gifts to the President PR003 Public Relations: Administrative Support - Incoming PR015-01 Public Relations: Broadcasts - Telecasts
