## **Summary**

This collection consists of material related to correspondence between Betty Friedan and Hillary Clinton. During the 1940's and 1950's, Betty Friedan was involved in the civil rights and women's rights movements. Friedan's influential book, *The Feminine Mystique*, was published in 1963. Friedan cofounded the National Organization for Women (NOW) in 1966, helped start the National Association for the Repeal of Abortion Laws in 1969, and continued her advocacy for women and the feminist movement through the 1970s and 1980s. The correspondence dates from 1993 to 1995 and contains invitations and replies to events exploring media coverage of women, symposiums on new paradigms for women and men, seminars on women and men in the workplace, and seminars on re-framing family values.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0997-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection consists of correspondence between Betty Friedan and Hillary Clinton dating from 1993 to 1995. Such correspondence consists of invitations and replies to events exploring media coverage of women, symposiums on new paradigms for women and men, seminars on women and men in the workplace, and seminars on reframing family values.

The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination.
