Summary

This collection consists of records relating to the relationship between Bolivia and the United States. The materials include information on former presidents of Bolivia Gonzalo Sanchez de Lozada and Hugo Banzer Suarez, former vice president Jorge Fernando "Tuto" Quiroga Ramirez, the nominations and appointments of former ambassadors to Bolivia - Curtis Warren Kamman and Donna Hrinak - and information about the Summit of the Americas on Sustainable Development that was held in Santa Cruz, Bolivia. The records also contain information about the history of Bolivia. The files contain correspondence, memorandum, diagrams, news clips, meeting notes, telegrams, cables, talking points, reports, briefing papers, and Hillary Rodham Clinton's schedule proposals, schedules, speeches, trip reports, and trip books.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2015-0894-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. FOIA 2015-0894-F contains records relating to the relationship between Bolivia and the United States, former Presidents of Bolivia Gonzalo Sanchez de Lozada and Hugo Banzer Suarez, former Vice President Jorge Fernando "Tuto" Quiroga Ramirez, material relating to the nominations and appointments of former ambassadors to Bolivia, Curtis Warren Kamman and Donna Hrinak, and information about the Summit of the Americas on Sustainable Development that was held in Santa Cruz, Bolivia. The collection also contains information about the First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton's trip to Bolivia for the Sixth Conference of the Wives of Heads of States and Governments of the Americas. The conference addressed the health of women and children, education, family violence, women in leadership roles and decision making, and children's rights. Additional topics covered include

maternal mortality, measles, political economic and social issues, women's issues, health, human rights, environmental issues, school feeding programs, drugs, small businesses, sustainable energy, biodiversity, pollution, and sustainable development. In addition, there is information about the history of Bolivia (including the political parties, ethnic breakdown, biological diversity, forest management, coca plant, drugs, and drug trafficking.), and information on the U.S. goals to help strengthen Bolivia's democracy and help eliminate narcotics trafficking. Records in this collection include correspondence, memorandum, diagrams, news clips, meeting notes, telegrams, cables, talking points, reports, briefing papers, and Hillary Rodham Clinton's schedule proposals, schedules, speeches, trip reports, and trip books.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas - Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, and Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. WHORM files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
