Summary

This collection consists of records related to the court case, Vernonia School District vs. Acton. This case addressed the constitutionality of the Oregon school board's policy to randomly drug test student athletes. This collection contains a statement from the President, memorandum regarding Vernonia vs. Acton, and weekly reports from the Department of Education and Department of Justice to the White House Chief of Staff.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2017-0924-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about additional related materials. FOIA 2017-0924-F consists of the court case, a statement from the President, memorandum, and email regarding Vernonia vs. Acton. In addition, there are weekly reports from the Department of Education and Department of Justice to the White House Chief of Staff. Vernonia School District vs. Acton concerned the constitutionality of the Oregon school board's policy to randomly drug test student athletes. The policy was challenged on the basis that it violated students' Fourth and Fourteenth amendment rights. The U.S. Supreme Court ruled in favor of the Oregon school board on June 26, 1995.
