Summary

This collection consists of Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created from November 16 through 18, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2006-1135-F (Segment 102) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created from November 16 through 18, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. Photographs from November 16, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton signs the Religious Freedom Restoration Act at the White House. Present are Vice President Al Gore, Senators Orrin Hatch, Mark Hatfield, and Howard Metzenbaum. Prior to the signing the President meets with senior staff including Melanne Verveer, Alexis Herman and David Dreyer, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the Governors' Endorsement on the North American Free Trade Agreement press conference. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan, Mickey Kantor, David Gergen, Mack McLarty, Bill Daley and Bill Frenzel, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton meets individually with Congressional Representatives regarding the North American Free Trade Agreement including Representatives John Bryan, Cynthia

McKinney, Bill Young, Mel Reynolds, and Floyd Flake. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Meiko and Masaichi Hattori at the White House. The Hattoris are parents of Yoshihiro Hattori, a Japanese exchange student who was killed in Louisiana in 1992. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with friends from Arkansas and a delegation from Alabama at two separate events. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a health care meeting. Present are Representatives Christopher Shays & Amory Houghton, Gwendolyn Harahan and Melanne Verveer, among others. Photographs from November 17, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs on The Mall and the US Capitol. President William Jefferson Clinton greets friends from Arkansas in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton talks on the telephone to members of Congress regarding the North American Free Trade Agreement. Present is Howard Paster. President William Jefferson Clinton meets individuals with Representatives regarding the North American Free Trade Agreement, including Representatives Martin Meehan, Edolphus Towns, and Floyd Flake. President William Jefferson Clinton watches the North American Free Trade Agreement vote with Vice President Al Gore. Present are Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore, Mack McLarty, and Jack Quinn, among others. Also includes shots of various senior staff watching the vote. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an event following the North American Free Trade Agreement vote in the "NAFTA War Room." Present are Vice President Al Gore, Bill Daley, Rahm Emanuel, Doris Matsui, Jim Free, Sid Blumenthal, Carol Rasco, George Stephanopoulos, Donsia Strong, and Patsy Thomasson, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets unidentified individuals in a hallway at the Old Executive Office Building. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore participate in a Congressional Spouses briefing regarding health care at the US Capitol. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a 20th Anniversary celebration for the Children's Defense Fund. Participants include Marian Wright Edelman, Maya Angelou, Wynton Marsalis, Debbie Allen, and Judy Collins, among others. Secretary Lloyd Bentsen gives a press briefing in the Press Briefing Room. Photographs from November 18, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs with Bill Singer (former baseball player). President William Jefferson Clinton tapes the weekly radio address in the Cabinet Room at the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting with Roy Neel, Bruce Lindsey, Mark Gearan, Ricki Seidman, Dee Dee Myers, and Stephanie Streett in the Oval Office. The President later meets with James Carville, Vice President Al Gore, and Rahm Emanuel. President William Jefferson Clinton greets Don Tyson, CEO of Tyson Foods, at the

White House. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with members of Congress following the passage of the North American Free Trade Agreement. Present are Vice President Al Gore, Bob Rubin, Senators John Danforth, Claiborne Pell, Charles Rob, and Dianne Feinstein, Representatives Tom Foley, George Mitchell, Robert Matsui, and Nancy Pelosi, among others. The President meets with Senator Sam Nunn privately in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton prepares for departing the White House en route to Seattle. Prior to leaving, he poses for a group photograph with staffers from Arkansas. He proceeds to a North American Free Trade Agreement victory rally with Vice President Al Gore on the South Lawn. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a meeting for the National Committee to Preserve Social Security and Medicare. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Representative Jim Bacchus and various health care professionals in the Indian Treaty Room at the White House. Montel Williams visits the White House.
