Summary

This collection consist of Clinton Administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created from November 3 through 6, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2006-1135-F (Segment 98) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created from November 3, 1993 through November 6, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. Photographs from November 3, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania en route to Ambridge, Pennsylvania. The President and First Lady arrive at the Laughlin Memorial Library in Ambridge. The President and First Lady later deliver speeches on health care reform at the Ambridge High School. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton depart from Pittsburgh en route to Andrews Air Force Base. The President and First Lady depart Andrews via Marine One en route to the South Lawn Landing Zone at the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests from Arkansas at the White House. Photographs from November 4, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson

Clinton jogs around the US Capitol. Upon returning to the White House, the President greets staff in the White House Staff Mess. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with members of Congress regarding the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). Present are Vice President Albert "Al" Gore, Jr., Representatives J. Roy Rowland, W.G. Bill Hefner, and Ike Skelton. President William Jefferson Clinton greets Dee Dee Myers, Nancy Hrenreich, Mary Anne Salmon, and Susie Whitacre on the White House Colonnade. The President later greets Dorothy Moore in the Oval Office. The President also greets Susan Brophy and Bill Daley. President William Jefferson Clinton departs the White House via Marine One en route to Lexington, Kentucky. The President arrives in Lexington and greets people on the tarmac. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) event at Lexmark International in Lexington. The President tours the facility with production manager Bob Vines. President William Jefferson Clinton greets volunteers and staff prior to boarding Air Force One. The President departs en route to Andrews Air Force Base. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview for Alumni Magazine with Nardi Reder. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives in Huntington, West Virginia. Present are Senator Jay Rockefeller, Representative Robert E. Wise, and Mayor Jean Kipp Dean. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Marshall University student union center. The First Lady delivers a speech on health care in the Don Morris room. Photographs from November 5, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs with friends. The President greets David Leopoldus, Jim French, and Phil Jamison. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert "Al" Gore, Jr., meet with members of Congress in the Oval Office. Present are George Stephanopoulos, David Gergen, Robert Rubin, Mack McLarty, and Senators Bob Kerrey and John Danforth. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert "Al" Gore, Jr., meet with the bipartisan congressional leadership in the Cabinet Room. Present include Representatives Steny Hoyer, Tom Foley, Bob Michel, and Newt Gingrich, Senators Wendell Ford, George Mitchell, and Thad Cochran, and staff members including Tim Keating, Thurgood Marshall, Jr., and George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with General Colin Powell at the White House. The President later signs the Veterans' Day Proclamation in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office to Midwestern farmers. Present is Secretary Mike Espy. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Governor Roy Romer of Colorado and Mayor Kurt Schmoke of Baltimore, Maryland. President William Jefferson Clinton greets staff and guests prior to a dinner at the

White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the New York Library Association at the Niagara Falls Convention and Civic Center. The First Lady participates in a meet and greet reception and also autographs books. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits Niagara Falls with Representatives John LaFalce, Sherwood Boehlert, and Maurice Hinchey. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton departs Niagara Falls International Airport. The First Lady arrives at Tompkins County Airport. The First Lady departs Ithaca en route to Andrews Air Force Base. Photographs from November 6, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address from the Oval Office.
