Summary

This collection consists of photographs from the Clinton administration taken from November 23rd through 25th, and from November 28th through 29th, 1993. This segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals; departures; meetings; ceremonies; press briefings; interviews; and other photo-ops., involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and members of the White House staff. A key event in this segment is a visit by South Korean President Kim Yongg-sam to the White House.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2006-1135-F (Segment 106) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created November 23 through 25, 1993, and November 28 through 29, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. Photographs from November 23, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton holds a press conference with President Kim Young-sam of South Korea. President William Jefferson Clinton signs HR 3225, South African Democratic Transition Support Act of 1993. Present are Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Ron Brown, and Tony Lake, Jesse Jackson, and Barney Frank. The family of Amy Biehl, a student killed in South Africa, are also present. The President speaks alone with Nancy Soderberg President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., greet members of Congress in the Oval Office. They participate in a meeting. President William Jefferson Clinton greets Commander Joe Walsh and his family in

the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial Commission. Present include Senators Mark Hatfield, Carl Levin and Daniel Inouye. Present also is Jack Valenti, Dorann Gunderson, Lorissa Bounds and Verne Newton. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in meetings with Chief of Staff of the Russian Presidential Executive Office Sergey Filatov and trade negotiator for the European Community Sir Leon Brittan. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host a state dinner for President Kim Young-sam and Mrs. Kim (Son Myoung-sun) of South Korea. The principals participate in a photo-op in the Grand Foyer and greet guests in the Cross Hall. The dinner is held in the State Dining Room. Following dinner, entertainment is provided by Jessye Norman in the East Room. Photographs from November 24, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs with President Kim Young-sam of South Korea at the White House President William Jefferson Clinton tapes the weekly radio address in the Old Executive Office Building. He greets staff and guests including Brenda Garcia, George Stephanopoulos, and Secretary Donna Shalala, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton is presented with the 1993 Thanksgiving turkey during the Thanksgiving turkey pardon event. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Mark Gearan. The President proceeds to a meeting with Senator Christopher Dodd in the West Wing. The President later greets guests at the White House including Marsha Scott's family and Mark Weiner's family, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with staff in the Outer Oval Office including Alexis Herman, Andrew Friendly, and George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at the Covenant Baptist Church. The President and First Lady prepare and serve Thanksgiving dinner for the homeless. Participants include Reverend Dennis Wiley, Pastor Reverend Christine Wiley, Reverend H. Wesley Wiley, Reverend Kenneth King, Church Committee Chair for the dinner Beverly Martin, and Coalition for the Homeless member Judy Dobbins, and Church Association for Community Service member Reverend Kwasi Thornell, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet portrait artist Alan Fischer and White House Curator Rex Scouten. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on behalf of the Brady Bill passage in the Oval Office. Present are Vice President Al Gore, Jr., James Brady, Janet Reno, Senators Robert Dole and George Mitchell, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone with British Prime Minister John Major. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a Technology Reinvestment Project Announcement media tour in the Old Executive Office Building

Staff portraits of Wendy Smith. Photographs from November 28, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Peter Capua at the White House. Photographs from November 29, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs with Steve Scott and George Kopp. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone with German Chancellor Helmut Kohl. Present are Nancy Soderberg, Jane Holl, Strobe Talbott, Sandy Berger and Charles Kupchan. President William Jefferson Clinton greets religious leaders in the AIDS community in the State Dining Room at the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton greets individuals at the White House including Glen Maes, Debi Schiff, and Carol Rasco. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Senators Barbara Mikulski and Phil Gramm, and Representative Richard Gephardt, among others, regarding a space station. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a budget meeting with David Gergen, Carol Rasco, Lloyd Bentsen, Robert Rubin, Laura Tyson, Leon Panetta, Howard Paster, Tony Lake, George Stephanopoulos, Robert Reich, Alan Blinder, and Roger Altman. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tapes a message for the New York Women's Agenda 1993 Star Breakfast "A Voice for Women." First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in the Pageant of Peace tree topping ceremony on The Ellipse.
