Approximately 2,532 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Summary

This collection consists of photographs from the Clinton administration taken from November 1st, and November 18th, through November 21st, 1993. This segment contains photographs related to: arrivals; departures; meetings; ceremonies; press briefings; and other photo-ops, involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and members of White House staff.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2006-1135-F (Segment 103) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created from November 1, 1993 & November 18, 1993 through November 21, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton and staff for the time period processed. Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
