**Summary**

This collection consists of National Security Council (NSC) records management documents regarding the first Summit of the Americas meeting in Miami, Florida on December 9 through 11, 1994. It contains memoranda regarding summit preparations, policy documents, and routine correspondence between western hemisphere Heads of State.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2012-0062-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This FOIA case contains National Security Council (NSC) records management documents regarding the inaugural Summit of the Americas in Miami, Florida on December 9 through 11, 1994. In December 1993, the Clinton Administration proposed the gathering of North, South, and Central American leaders in the interest of furthering international relations, promoting trade, and supporting democracy in the Western Hemisphere. The NSC materials responsive to this topic date from 1994 through early 1995 and include routine Head of State correspondence in anticipation of the summit as well as memoranda between NSC staff regarding preparations and policy documents.
