## **Summary**

This collection consists of National Security Council (NSC) records management documents regarding the second Summit of the Americas meeting in Santiago, Chile on April 18 and 19, 1998. It contains memoranda, reports, and papers regarding preparation for the summit and subsequent follow-up on its initiatives.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2018-0064-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. FOIA 2018-0064-F contains National Security Council (NSC) records management documents related to United States participation in the 1998 Summit of the Americas in Santiago, Chile on April 18 and 19, 1998. This was the second in a series of regular summits after the first one in Miami in 1994. The files, which date from late 1997 through late 1998, contain memoranda, reports, and papers regarding preparation before the summit and subsequent follow-up on its initiatives. The researcher should be aware that many of the more sensitive records have been withheld for national security reasons. The researcher should also note that a majority of numbered documents responsive to this case were previously processed for, and are located in this open FOIA collection: 2009-1155-F President Clinton's South America Trips in 1997 and 1998
