Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-0820-F (Segment 2) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection consists of records related to Mark Middleton. This collection consists of email correspondence from Mark Middleton, to Mark Middleton, and concerning Mark Middleton. Mark Middleton served in the Office of the Chief of Staff from 1993 to 1995. Middleton held several professional titles while working in the Chief of Staff's office including, Assistant to the Chief of Staff, Special Assistant to the Chief of Staff, and Deputy to the Counselor. Email correspondence from Mark Middleton primarily contains WAVES (Worker and Visitor Entry System) requests. WAVES requests are emailed requests for White House guests made to White House Security. WAVES are often heavily redacted because they contain Personally Identifiable Information. Email correspondence to Mark Middleton consists of information concerning Presidential travel, news clips, and the Chief of Staff's (Mack McLarty) weekly schedules. Email correspondence containing Mark Middleton in the email's "Subject" field consist of WAVES requests, and pager confirmations. Pager confirmations are emails confirming text messages sent through page service. Email correspondence containing Mark Middleton's name in the "Text" field consists of WAVES requests, news clips, White House Press Briefings, and the Chief of Staff's (Mack McLarty) weekly schedules

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Automated Records Management System [Email]. The Executive Office of the President (EOP) subsystem of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Clinton Administration officials. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain.
