Summary

This collection consists of records related to Howard Paster, Assistant to the President for Legislative Affairs, who served as the chief congressional relations officer for President Clinton in 1993. In addition to unsolicited letters of recommendations for White House employment, correspondence includes concerns from professional organizations and Congress, meetings with Members of Congress, White House memos on strategy on various pieces of legislation, and presidential phone calls recommended by Paster. The collection also contains clippings, draft legislation, markups, and publications.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0557-F (Segment 2) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection consists of documents related to Howard Paster, Assistant to the President for Legislative Affairs, who served as the chief congressional relations officer for President Clinton in 1993. Paster's work with the Clinton Administration's legislative efforts included health care reform, President Clinton's budget plan, and the North American Free Trade Agreement or NAFTA. In addition to unsolicited letters of recommendations for White House employment, correspondence includes concerns from professional organizations and Congress, meetings with Members of Congress, White House memos on strategy on various pieces of legislation, and presidential phone calls recommended by Paster. The collection also contains clippings, draft legislation, and markups. Publications include Congressional Research Services reports, Democratic Study Group's Special Reports, DPC Legislative Bulletins, DSC Legislative Reports, and publications of professional organizations. Topics in the Subject File include the Bosnia conflict, the economic

plan, and national service.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alpha Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject File, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM (CL), and Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 – 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM (CL) files. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
