## **Summary**

This collection consists of photographs from the Clinton administration taken from November 30 through December 4, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2006-1135-F (Segment 108) is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created November 30 through December 4, 1993. President William Jefferson Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Democratic National Committee dinner participants in the East Room at the White House. Photographs from December 2, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton converses with staff prior to a budget meeting in the Cabinet Room at the White House. Present are Leon Panetta, John Podesta, Bowman Cutter, William Galston, and Christine Varney. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in videotaping sessions in the Roosevelt Room at the

White House. Present are Wendy Smith, Debi Schiff, Stephanie Streett, and David Gergen, among others. President Clinton is interviewed by Tom Brokaw. The President proceeds to an interview with Hedrick Smith of PBS in the Oval Office. Alexis Herman is present. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore Jr., greet David Mixner at the White House. Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center. The First Lady participates in a health care discussion with professors in the Fuller Board Room. The First Lady has lunch with women professors in Auditorium B. The First Lady tours the facility. Following the events at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center, the First Lady Proceeds to Dartmouth College for a health care event. Participants include Governor Howard Dean, James Freedman, and Charles Everett Koop. Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Lebanon Municipal Airport in Lebanon, New Hampshire. She is met by Mayor David Jescavage, among others. Hillary Rodham Clinton greets volunteers, police & state troopers as she departs Lebanon, New Hampshire. The First Lady arrives at Manchester Airport. She is met by Governor Stephen Merrill and Mrs. Heather Merrill whom have their baby with them. Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Manchester Community Health Service. She participates in a discussion with patients in the reception area. Hillary Rodham Clinton greets volunteers and police prior to departing from Manchester, New Hampshire. Staffers are pictured in the Outer Oval Office, including Betty Currie, Alice Honen, Dee Dee Myers, Wendy Smith, Alexis Herman, and Mark Gearan. Photographs from December 3, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the Democratic Leadership Council at the Sheraton Washington Hotel in Washington, DC. President William Jefferson Clinton departs the White House for New Mexico and California. The President speaks on the telephone with President Francois Mitterrand aboard Air Force One. Present are Dee Dee Myers, Bruce Lindsey, and Will Itoh, among others. The President arrives at Albuquerque, New Mexico. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a Rural Health Care Event in Bernalillo, New Mexico. Events include interview with regional press and a town hall format question & answer session at El Pueblo Health Services, Inc. President William Jefferson Clinton address a reception at the Albuquerque Convention Center East. Present include Representative Bill Richardson, Senator Jeff Bingaman, Governor Bruce King, among others. Later the President departs Albuquerque en route to Los Angeles, California. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at the White House including Elaine Weiss and Christy Walton. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a health care meeting in the White House with Mike Lux, Mandy Grunwald, Bob Boorstin, Maggie Williams,

and Dick Celeste among others. President William Jefferson Clinton posing for a photograph with Howard Paster and the staff of Legislative Affairs in the Oval Office of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton greets Ketumile Masire, President of the Republic of Botswana in the Oval Office of the White House and later greets Douglas Fraser, former President of the United Auto Workers Union in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton talking with staff in the Oval Office of the White House. Present include National Security Advisor Tony Lake, Nancy Hennreich, Ricki Seidman, and George Stephanopoulos. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB) with students from Page High School in North Carolina as part of Caring Makes Cents. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton speaks to the National Council on Aging in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Derek Shearer and Ruth Galway in the White House. Photographs from December 4, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a California Economic Roundtable at Rockwell International. Present include Secretary Ron Brown, Mayor Richard Riordan, and Senators Dianne Feinstein & Barbara Boxer, among others. Following the roundtable meeting, the President greets & addresses Rockwell employees and tours the facilities.
