Summary

The collection consists of photographs created from December 20, 1993 through December 25, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2006-1135-F (Segment 114) is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment were created December 20 through 25, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. A focal point of this particular segment is various festivities for the holiday leading up to Christmas Day. Photographs from December 20, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet staff at a Christmas reception. Photographs from December 21, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in the final budget meeting for 1993. Present are Robert Rubin, Laura Tyson, Alice Rivlin, Leon Panetta, Carol Rasco, and Alan Blinder, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton works with Betty Currie. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with David Gergen, Maggie Williams, and Thomas "Mack" McLarty. President William Jefferson Clinton greets relatives of the victims of the Pan Am Flight 103 bombing. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address a United Nations International Children's Fund (UNICEF) event at the White House. President

William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests at a Christmas reception. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a meeting with corporate executive officers, present are Paul Allaire, CEO of Xerox, Edwin Artzt, CEO of Procter & Gamble, George Fisher, CEO of Eastman Kodak, Joseph Gorman, CEO of TRW, and Harold Poling, Former CEO of Ford Motor Company. Staff present include Melanne Vermeer, Ira Magaziner, Alexis Herman, and Roger Altman. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton signs a deed of gift donating her 1993 inaugural gown to The Smithsonian Institution. President William Jefferson Clinton tries out a putter in the Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in interviews with Gene Gibbons of Reuters, Helen Thomas of United Press International, Ron Fournier of the Associated Press, and an extended meeting with Style Section reporters. Socks is photographed with Christmas décor. Photographs from December 22, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets various guests in separate greetings in the Oval Office. They include Governor Dick Celeste, Jeanne McDaniel, Douglas Paschall, Ted Van Dyke, Mark Levy, and Maggie Williams. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton later greets Maggie Williams in a separate greeting. President William Jefferson Clinton makes an announcement regarding the homeless. Present include Mrs. Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore, Henry Cisneros, and Pastor John Steinbruck. President William Jefferson Clinton has a meeting with staff. Present are Leon Panetta, Robert Rubin, George Stephanopoulos, and Thomas "Mack" McLarty, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in interviews with Linda Wertheimer of National Public Radio, and separate interviews with both wire service and radio reporters. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in an interview with Arkansas press. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone with President Boris Yeltsin of Russia. President William Jefferson Clinton records his Christmas Day address. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a taping session at the Old Executive Office Building. Photographs from December 24, 1993 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone to U.S. Troops. He later greets guests at the White House.
