One betacam video recording reviewed in part and processed.

Summary

The video recording processed in this case was created on February 28, 1997. The case contains White House Television video (WHTV) footage of President Clinton delivering his weekly radio address in the Roosevelt Room. The subject of the address is focused on the fight against illegal drugs. Following the radio address President Clinton meets and greets guests for photo opportunities including Monica Lewinsky and others in the Oval Office.

Scope and Content Note

The material in FOIA 2018-0796-F is a selective video responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. FOIA request 2018-0796-F includes one selected master tape video recording from the White House Television Office (WHTV). The video recording contains approximately seven minutes of the President delivering his weekly Radio Address in the Roosevelt Room to an audience. Office of National Drug Control Policy Director Barry McCaffrey is present next to the President during the Radio Address. The subject of the address is focused on the fight against illegal drugs. Following the Radio Address President Clinton meets and greets Monica Lewinsky and others for photos in the Oval Office. The meet and greet video is approximately three minutes in duration. The Radio Address is broadcasted on March 1, 1997.
