This collection consists of records regarding the World Congress of the Russian Press (WARP). WARP began in 1999 as a non-governmental organization for Russian language media and meets annually. It contains a National Security Council (NSC) email reporting on remarks made at the June 1999 meeting in Sochi, Russia

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2018-0778-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This FOIA contains records on the World Congress of the Russian Press (WARP). WARP was established in 1999 as a non-governmental organization for Russian language media. Its stated goals are to strengthen and foster relationships within the Russian press community. There were two annual meetings of WARP during the Clinton Administration. The first meeting took place in Moscow and Sochi, Russia in June 1999. The second meeting took place in New York and Washington, D.C. in April 2000. WARP continues to meet annually. The material in this case consists of a National Security Council (NSC) email reporting on remarks made at the 1999 meeting. One NSC cable was processed in the response to the request, but it has been withheld for national security reasons.
