Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2008-0666-F (Segment 17) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from July 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000. The photographs processed in this segment were created from September 15, 2000 and September 19, 2000 through September 22, 2000. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, staff and others for the time period processed. Photographs from September 15, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a briefing for the visit of Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee of India. Present are Madeleine Albright, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Donald Kerrick, John Podesta, Gene Sperling, Strobe Talbott, Richard Celeste (Ambassador to India) and Bruce Riedel. Photographs from September 19, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets Boys and Girls Club of America 'Youth of the Year' in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a briefing regarding the Middle East in the Oval Office. Present are Madeleine Albright, Sandy Berger, George Tenet, Dennis Ross, Bruce Riedel, Rob Malley, Mara Rudman, Leon Fuerth, Gamal Helal, and Aaron Miller. President William Jefferson Clinton greets Boys and Girls Club 'Youth of the Year' in

the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with members of the Hispanic Congressional Caucus in the Cabinet Room at the White House. Present include Bill Richardson, Aida Alvarez, Representative Xavier Becerra, Grace Napolitano, Lucille Roybal-Allard, Robert Underwood, Luis Gutierrez, Loretta Sanchez, Ruben Hinojosa, Robert Menendez, Charles Gonzalez, Ciro Rodriguez, Jose Serrano, Carlos Romero-Barcelo, Silvestre Reyes, and Solomon Ortiz. President William Jefferson Clinton is briefed in the Oval Office prior to delivering remarks to the press. Present are Joe Lockhart, Sandy Berger, John Podesta, Chuck Brain, Gene Sperling, Donald Kerrick, and Steve Ricchetti. The President delivers remarks in the Press Briefing Room on the Senate passage of Permanent Normal Trade Relations with China (PNTR). Joe Lockhart is pictured next to the President on stage. President William Jefferson Clinton delivers remarks at the debut of 'Speak Truth to Power: Voices from Beyond the Darkness' at the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC. President William Jefferson Clinton delivers remarks at the National Hispanic Foundation for the Arts dinner at the Mayflower Hotel in Washington, DC. Photographs from September 20, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton delivers remarks at the Church of God in Christ Annual Bishop's Convention at the Renaissance Hotel in Washington, DC. Present are Bishops Felton Smith, P.A. Brooks, J. Neul Haynes, Chandler Owens, and L.T. Walker. The President is later photographed returning to the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Terry Edmonds, Josh Gottheimer, and John Podesta in the Outer Oval Office. The President accepts a prize from German media in the Oval Office. Later the President greets General Service Administration (GSA) staff in the Oval Office. (September 20, 2000 continued) President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone. Following the call the President speaks with Madeleine Albright, Dennis Ross, Bruce Riedel, Mara Rudman, Rob Malley, and John Podesta, whom are present. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Prime Minister Giuliano Amato of Italy in the Oval Office. The President and Prime Minister look at gifts in the Outer Oval Office. They then proceed to an expanded meeting in the Cabinet Room. Following the meeting they proceed to the State Dining Room for a working luncheon. President William Jefferson Clinton accepts the German Media Prize in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the Congressional Hispanic Caucus at the MCI Center in Washington, DC. The President is introduced by Representative Lucille Roybal-Allard. Photographs from September 21, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a briefing regarding the Conversation And Reinvestment Act (CARA). Present are Joe Lockhart, Chuck Brain,

Roger Ballentine, George Frampton, Loretta Ucelli, and John Podesta. The President proceeds to the Rose Garden and delivers remarks on CARA. Later the President greets individuals present at the White House in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton departs the South Lawn via Marine One en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President departs en route Flint, Michigan. Present on the trip are Norman Mineta, James Clark, Carl Augusto, Judy Heumann, Maria Echaveste, and Elliot Diringer, among others. The President arrives at Flint Bishop International Airport. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at The Disability Network. The President takes a tour of various technology demonstrations, accompanied by Executive Director Mike Zelle. The President proceeds to Mott Community College where he delivers remarks on the digital divide. Present include Norman Mineta and Mayor Woodrow Stanley, among others. Around this time frame, the President also greets individuals present roadside in Flint, Michigan. President William Jefferson Clinton departs Flint en route Detroit, Michigan. The President proceeds to an event for the State Bar of Michigan at the Atheneum Suite Hotel. The President later departs Detroit at Willow Run Airport en route Andrews Air Force Base. Photographs from September 22, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society group in the Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in photo shoots for Talk Magazine and The New Yorker at the White House. (September 22, 2000 continued) President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in the Oval Office. The President greets guests present. Later the President signs the Religious Land Use & Institutionalized Persons Act of 2000 in the Oval Office. Present are Senators Harry Reid and Ted Kennedy, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton greets the families of Madeleine Albright and President Harry Truman at the White House in separate events. President William Jefferson Clinton delivers a web address at the White House regarding the internet.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
