Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2008-0666-F (Segment 20) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from July 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000. The photographs processed in this segment were created from October 5, 2000 through October 6, 2000 and October 8, 2000 through October 11, 2000. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, staff and others for the time period processed. Photographs from October 5, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton delivers remarks to the conference on the progressive tradition at Princeton University. Present include Princeton President Harold Shapiro, Sean Wilentz, Katharine Gilbert, and Michael Rothschild. Later the President proceeds to Trenton County Airport en route New York. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives in New York, NY. The President greets drivers at the Supper Club. Prominent among the guests are Kevin Spacey whom is photographed outside the club with the President. The President departs New York via Air Force One en route Andrews Air Force Base. Photographs from October 6, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton signs various bills and legislation in the Oval Office. The President signs HR 2909, the Intercountry Adoption Act of 2000.

Present is Representative Sheila Jackson, among others. The President signs the Small Business Export Task Force Executive Order. Present are Senators Jesse Helms & Mary Landrieu, and Representative Sam Gejdenson, among others. The President signs the Increasing Opportunities and Access for Disadvantaged Businesses Executive Order. Present are Representatives Albert Wynn & Carolyn Kilpatrick, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address. The President greets guests in attendance including Jennifer Palmieri, among others. Present also is Samuel "Sandy" Berger whom confers with the President. President William Jefferson Clinton delivers a statement regarding the election in the Republic of Serbia. Prior to the statement the President confers with senior staff. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office with Chancellor Gerhardt Schroeder of Germany. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in separate interviews and photo shoots with Vanity Fair and Rolling Stone magazines. The President participates an interview with David Friend of Vanity Fair. Vanity Fair photographer Harry Benson is present. The President participates in a photo shoot with Herb Ritts of Rolling Stone President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office. Photographs from October 8, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Andrews Air Force Base aboard Marine One. The President boards Air Force One. Photographs from October 9, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton departs Westchester County Airport en route Andrews Air Force Base. Present is Chelsea Clinton. The President arrives at Andrews Air Force base. (Photographs from October 9, 2000 continued) President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Secretary of State Madeleine Albright, Sandy Berger, Dennis Ross, and John Podesta in the Oval Office. The President participates in separate telephone calls with Ehud Barak of Israel and Yasser Arafat of the Palestinian Authority. Also present are Steve Ricchetti and Aaron Miller. Photographs from October 10, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets special envoy Vice Marshall Cho Myong-Rok of North Korea. Present are Madeleine Albright, Sandy Berger, Wendy Sherman, John Podesta, and the North Korean delegation, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton signs various bills at the White House. Among them are S. 1295, Lance Corporal Harold Gomez Post Office, S. 1324, Gettysburg National Military Park, H.R. 999, Beaches Environmental Assessment and Costal Health Act of 2000, H.R. 2647, Water Rights of the AkChin Indian Community, HR 3363, Relief of Akal Security Incorporated, H.R. 4700, to grant the consent of the Congress to the Kansas and Missouri metropolitan culture district compact, and H.J. Resolution 72, granting the consent of the Congress to the Red

River boundary compact. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the China Permanent Trade Relations Event (PNTR) on the South Lawn at the White House. The President signs H.R. 4444, to authorize extension of nondiscriminatory treatment to the People's Republic of China and to establish a framework for relations between the United States and the People's Republic of China. Present are Madeleine Albright, Dennis Hastert, Lisel Loy, Loretta Ucelli, Steve Ricchetti, Sandy Berger, Gene Sperling, Mary Beth Cahill, Bill Daley, and Chuck Brain. Representatives present include Charles Rangel, Ken Bentsen, Ruben Hinojosa, Ellen Tauscher, Cal Dooley, George Brown, and Jim Moran. Senators present include Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Trent Lott, Patrick Leahy, Carl Levin, Strom Thurmond, William Roth, and Bob Graham. President William Jefferson Clinton is interviewed by Jann Wenner of Rolling Stone Magazine. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in separate telephone calls with Ehud Barak of Israel and Yasser Arafat of the Palestinian Authority. Present are Madeleine Albright, Sandy Berger, Mara Rudman, Dennis Ross, Gamal Helal, Bob Malley, Aaron Miller., Bruce Riedel, and Donald Kerrick

Photographs from October 11, 2000 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton signs H.R. 4578, the Department of the Interior and Related Agencies Appropriations Act of 2001. Present are Representatives Norm Dicks & Ralph Regula, Bruce Babbitt, and Jack Lew, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton departs the White House via the Presidential limousine. Miscellaneous photographs from October 10, 2000 are as follows: Staff portraits of Jake Siewert.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
