Summary

This collection consists of records related to Dr. Pascal Forgione, an educator and school administrator who served as the Commissioner of the National Center for Education Statistics in the U.S. Department of Education from 1994 through 1999. It contains scheduling material related to the announcement of the Third International Mathematics and Science Study, a Nexis/Lexis search result that contains Dr. Forgione's name, other magazine and news stories concerning Dr. Forgione, his personnel file and extensive resume, correspondence with Dr. Forgione including a commendatory letter from the President and a letter from Dr. Forgione to the President concerning the 1996 Delaware State Teacher of the Year Award.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2018-0563-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Dr. Pascal (Pat) Forgione, an educator and school administrator, who served as the Commissioner of the National Center for Education Statistics in the U.S. Department of Education from 1994 through 1999. The records processed in response to this FOIA request include scheduling material related to the announcement of the Third International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS), a Nexis/Lexis search result that contains Dr. Forgione's name, other magazine and news stories concerning Dr. Forgione, his personnel file and resume, correspondence with Dr. Forgione including a commendatory letter from the President and a letter from Dr. Forgione to the President concerning the 1996 Delaware State Teacher of the Year Award. Email records include White House correspondence concerning Dr. Forgione's nomination and the results of the Third International Math and Science Study (TIMSS). Email records also include speech drafts, press releases, and press

briefings concerning Dr. Forgione and TIMSS.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Alpha Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files, and Clinton Presidential Records: ARMS Emails. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 - 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. WHORM files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The ARMS database is comprised of six sub-series of email records called "buckets." The buckets generally represent a specific White House office. The buckets are titled: NPR for National Performance Review, OPD for Office of Policy Development, POTUS for President of the United States, WHO for White House Office, CEA for Council of Economic Advisers, and Default for emails not associated with an office. The OPD bucket contains email created or received by an individual with an Office of Policy Development (OPD) White House user account. The WHO bucket contains email created or received by individual with an Executive Office of the President White House user account not

identified as CEA, NPR, or OPD. The Default bucket contains email created or received by unknown or un-recognized email accounts. Email found within the Default bucket often includes email created or received by offices or individuals outside the Executive Office of the President. ARMS emails are arranged by topic, there-under by bucket, and there-under chronologically by creation date. FOIA 2018-0563-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: [FG026] [Federal Government, Department of Education] [PE002] [Personnel Management, Employment / Appointments]

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
