## **Summary**

This collection consists of records related to Tony Blair, the United Kingdom, and Britain found within the National Economic Council office. It contains background material, reports and briefing papers.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2018-0413-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The researcher submitted for a request for a series of keywords to be searched in the National Economic Council files. The only responsive keywords were: Tony Blair; United Kingdom; and Britain. Records related to this request were found in the National Security Council's International Economic Affairs office. The records to be opened include background material and briefing papers, primarily concerning the G-8 Summit held in Birmingham in 1998, where discussion topics included economic issues, drugs & crime, and nuclear safety. The majority of the records responsive to this FOIA case are closed for national security reasons.

Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
