Summary

This collection consists of White House Office of Records Management records related to American film critic, Robert Ebert. It contains correspondence from Ebert regarding attendance at the Conference on World Affairs, White House staff memorandum to President Clinton regarding interviews with Ebert, scheduling materials regarding interviews with Ebert, correspondence from President Clinton to Ebert regarding such interviews, and correspondence between President Clinton and various film producers mentioning Ebert. The materials date from 1998 to 2000.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 - 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. WHORM files are processed at the document level. FOIA 2018-1124-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: FG001-07 Appointments Granted, Presidential GI002 Gifts to the President PR015-01 Broadcasts - Telecasts SP230-00 State of the Union, 2000.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C.
