Summary

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2018-1126-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. FOIA request 2018-1126-F contains photographs from December 18, 1999 of President Clinton participating in a "Movies of the Century" interview with Roger Ebert of "Roger Ebert and the Movies" in the Roosevelt Room at the White House. President Clinton and Roger Ebert give Ebert's customary "Thumbs Up" during the interview. Other events on the responsive photograph contact sheets include: Kris Engsov, Joe Lockhart and Betty Currie with Socks the Cat in the Outer Oval Office and President Clinton participating in a "Sports Greats of the Century" interview in the Cabinet Room at the White House with Stuart Scott of ESPN's "Sportscenter" program.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact Sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
