Summary

This collection consists of records related to the February 1995 visit of Thabo Mbeki, Deputy President of South Africa. It contains briefing books, State Department cables, emails, and policy papers about the Gore-Mbeki commission.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2017-0714-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Thabo Mbeki became Deputy President of South Africa in May 1994 and succeeded Nelson Mandela as President in June of 1999. He was subsequently re-elected for a second term in 2004. As Deputy President, Mr. Mbeki visited the United States in February / March 1995 and met with Vice-President Gore at the Naval Observatory in Washington D.C. The binational "Gore-Mbeki Commission" (named after Vice President Al Gore and South African Deputy President Thabo Mbeki) was formed to help increase development efforts within South Africa. This collection consists of briefing books for Vice President Gore's use in preparing for the binational commission, National Security Council and State Department cables sent in preparation of the Deputy President's visit to Washington D.C., and e-mails between staffers as they prepared to brief Vice President Gore and President Clinton on their meetings with Deputy President Mbeki.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files, and Clinton Presidential Records: NSC Cable, Email, and Records Management Systems. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. WHORM files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. FOIA 2017-0714-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: PR005-01 Public Relations, Photographs Granted, Presidential.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
