This collection consists of unclassified electronic records regarding David Lipton and events during the Kosovo conflict. David Lipton served in the Clinton administration at the Treasury Department from 1993 to 1998. It contains cables and NSC email that cover topics such as travel arrangements and public diplomacy efforts.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-0331-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. David Lipton served in the Clinton administration at the Treasury Department from 1993 to 1998. As Under Secretary of the Treasury for International Affairs — and before that as Assistant Secretary - Lipton helped lead the Treasury's response to the financial crisis in Asia and the effort to modernize the international financial architecture. The majority of these records related to this FOIA case are closed for national security reasons.
