## **Summary**

This collection consists of records related to Maryanne Trump Barry who was an attorney for the District of New Jersey and is President Donald Trump's older sister. President Ronald Reagan nominated Barry to a seat on the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey in 1983. It contains collections of court cases that were handled by Judge Barry, copies of Judge Barry's most significant court cases, her writing samples from some court cases, and emails containing news articles and press releases regarding her 1999 judicial appointment. The collection also contains correspondence, memoranda, speeches, talking points and various questionnaires for Judge Barry's appointment to the 3rd Circuit Court of New Jersey.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2019-0481-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Maryanne Trump Barry was an attorney for the District of New Jersey and is President Donald Trump's older sister. Barry earned her law degree in 1974 from Hofstra University School of Law. She became an Assistant United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey in 1974 and held that position until 1983. She served in the civil division of the court from 1974 to 1975 and the appeals division from 1976 to 1982. During this time Barry had served as deputy chief, chief, Executive Assistant United States Attorney and then First Assistant United States Attorney. On September 14, 1983 President Ronald Reagan nominated Barry to a seat on the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey. On October 6, 1983 Barry was confirmed by the United States Senate and received her commission the next day. Barry held that position until 1999 when President William J. Clinton nominated her for the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. Barry was confirmed

unanimously by the United States Senate on September 13, 1999 and on September 22, 1999 she received her commission. Barry took senior status in June of 2011, inactive senior status in February of 2017 and she retired on February 11, 2019. Records in FOIA 2019-0481-F consist mainly of collections of court cases that were handled by Judge Barry, copies of Judge Barry's most significant court cases, her writing samples from some court cases, and emails containing news articles and press releases regarding her 1999 judicial appointment. The collection also contains correspondence, memoranda, speeches, talking points and various questionnaires for Judge Barry's appointment to the 3rd Circuit Court of New Jersey. Some of the topics covered include the Sentencing Reform Act, Federal Sentencing Guidelines, Violent Youth Predator Act of 1996, S.J. Resolution 52 -Victims of Crime Constitutional Amendment and Balanced Juvenile Justice and Crime Prevention Act of 1996.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management [WHORM] Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files, and Clinton Presidential Records: ARMS Emails. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. WHORM files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of

the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The ARMS database is comprised of seven sub-series of email records called "buckets." The buckets generally represent a specific White House office. The buckets are titled: NPR for National Performance Review, OPD for Office of Policy Development, POTUS for President of the United States, WHO for White House Office, CEA for Council of Economic Advisers, NSC for National Security Council, and Default for emails not associated with an office. The NPR bucket contains email created or received by an individual with a National Performance Review (NPR) White House user account. The OPD bucket contains email created or received by an individual with an Office of Policy Development (OPD) White House user account. The POTUS bucket was designated for email created and received by the President of the United States (POTUS). Please note that President Clinton never used his POTUS White House user account to send the few emails he wrote while in office. The WHO bucket contains email created or received by an individual with an Executive Office of the President White House user account not identified as CEA, NPR, or OPD. The CEA bucket contains email created or received by an individual with a Council of Economic Advisors (CEA) White House user account. The NSC bucket contains email created or received by an individual with a National Security Council (NSC) user account. The Default bucket contains email created or received by unknown or un-recognized email accounts. Email found within the Default bucket often includes email created or received by offices or individuals outside the Executive Office of the President. ARMS email are arranged by topic, there-under by bucket, and there-under chronologically by creation date. FOIA 2019-0481-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: FG017 Federal Government-Organizations - Department of Justice FG035 Federal Government-Organizations - Senate PE002 Personnel Management - Employment - Appointments PE002-01 Personnel Management - Schedule C Appointments.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
