Summary

This collection consists of records related to Mark Gearan and Kosovo from March 1, 1999 to July 1, 2000. Mark Gearan was Director of the Peace Corps from 1995-1999 and held several different positions in the Clinton Administration from 1993-1995. It contains only emails.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-0500-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult FOIA case 2011-0584-F for other records related to Mark Gearan. This collection consists of an email containing news clips regarding Kosovo and the Peace Corps. Mark Gearan was Director of the Peace Corps from 1995-1999. Prior to this appointment, he served in the Clinton Administration as White House Deputy Chief of Staff, Assistant to the President of the United States, and Director of Communications and Strategic Planning.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas—Clinton Presidential Records: ARMS Emails. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential

email. The ARMS database is comprised of seven sub-series of email records called "buckets." The buckets generally represent a specific White House office. The Default bucket contains email created or received by unknown or un-recognized email accounts. Email found within the Default bucket often includes email created or received by offices or individuals outside the Executive Office of the President. ARMS email are arranged by topic, there-under by bucket, and there-under chronologically by creation date.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 U.S.C. Chapter 1) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.
