Summary

This collection consists of unclassified electronic records regarding Gary Samore and meetings between US officials and South African delegations between 1992 and 1995 during which the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR) and missile nonproliferation was discussed. It contains National Security Council cables and emails which include talking points, memos, presidential statements, and press briefings. Subjects include the International Atomic Energy Agency, UN General Assembly committee meetings, a nuclear weapon free zone treaty in Southeast Asia, computer export control, and the 1995 National Security Strategy Report.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-0395-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The requester asked for information related to Clinton staffer Gary Samore (Special Assistant to the President and Senior Director for Nonproliferation and Export Controls, 1995-2000) and meetings between US officials and South African delegations between 1992 and 1995 during which the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR) and missile nonproliferation was discussed. Records responsive to this request include NSC cables and emails which covered draft talking points, memos, presidential statements, and press briefings. Subjects include the International Atomic Energy Agency's program of technical assistance with peaceful uses of nuclear technology, highlights of the UN General Assembly's committee meetings, a nuclear weapon free zone treaty in Southeast Asia, computer export control, and the 1995 National Security Strategy Report.
