Summary

This collection consists of records related to a meeting between the White House Communications Office and documentary filmmaker, Ken Burns. This collection contains two emails concerning informal group discussions between White House communications staff and noteworthy professionals. The collection also consists of two records from the Worker and Visitor Entry database that records Ken Burns entrance to the White House at the request of White House Communications Director, Don Baer.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0195-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The FOIA collection consists of records related to a meeting between the White House Communications Office and documentary filmmaker, Ken Burns. Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: Automated Records Management System [Email]; and Clinton Presidential Records The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The ARMS database is comprised of six sub-series of email records called "buckets." The buckets generally represent a specific White House office. The buckets are titled: NPR for National Performance Review, OPD for Office of Policy Development, POTUS for President of the United States, WHO for White House Office, CEA for Council of Economic Advisers, and Default for emails not associated with an office. The Electronic WAVES Search System is a log of visitors/appointments to the White House and is arranged by name of visitor there-under by date.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright
