Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from January 1, 1994 through January 9, 1994, and January 12, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 1) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created from January 1, 1994 through January 9, 1994 & January 12, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed. Photographs from January 1, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at Arthur Hills Golf Course in Hilton Head, South Carolina. Later, the President addresses a seminar during the Renaissance Weekend at the Hyatt Hotel. Photographs from January 2, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets South Carolina wildlife and game police. The President proceeds to the Hilton Head landing zone for departure via Marine One, en route to Air Force One. The President greets personnel and individuals in attendance, departing South Carolina en route Andrews Air Force Base. Later, the President arrives at the South Lawn of the White House. Photographs from January 3, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with senior staff in the Oval Office. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Ricki Seidman, Mack

McLarty, George Stephanopoulos, David Gergen, John Podesta, and Gene Sperling. Later, the President and Vice President meet with Strobe Talbot, Tony Lake, Nicholas Burns, Sandy Berger, and Leon Fuerth. Following the meetings, the President, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and George Stephanopoulos confer prior to meeting in the cabinet room regarding the 1994 agenda and health care. President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Al Gore, and Tipper Gore meet with senior cabinet members regarding the Clinton Administration's health care plan. Present includes Janet Reno, Robert Reich, Jesse Brown, Donna Shalala, Lloyd Bentsen, Ron Brown, Robert Reich, Henry Cisneros, Alice Rivlin, Laura Tyson, Bob Boorstin, David Gergen, George Stephanopoulos, Phil Lader, Mark Gearan, Pat Griffin, Judy Feder, Christine Varney, and Steve Ricchetti, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a briefing for an upcoming trip to Europe. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Tony Lake, Leon Fuerth, Strobe Talbott, Mark Gearan, David Gergen, Nicholas Burns, Ricki Seidman, Sandy Berger, Jenonne Walker, John Podesta, Don Steinberg, Jeremy Rosner, and George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with Elizabeth Drew. Photographs from January 4, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Prime Minister Ruud Lubbers of the Netherlands. Present includes Vice President Al Gore, Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Dee Dee Myers, Mary Masserini, and Jenonne Walker, among others. The press pool is present for a photo opportunity prior to the meeting. President William Jefferson Clinton has dinner with advisors on foreign affairs. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Warren Christopher, Les Aspin, Tony Lake, Sandy Berger, Leon Fuerth, George Stephanopoulos, Nicholas Burns, Nancy Soderberg, General John Shalikashvili, Condaleeza Rice. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with leaders from Ukraine in Tony Lake's office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Prime Minister Ruud Lubbers of the Netherlands, Present includes Melanne Vermeer and Ira Magaziner. General John Shalikashvili briefs the press in the Press Briefing Room at the White House. Photographs from January 5, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton is briefed prior to a luncheon with columnists. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Jack Quinn, Michael Waldman, Mark Gearan, Dee Dee Myers, Howard Paster, Lisa Caputo, Mack McLarty, George Stephanopoulos, and Tony Lake. Following the briefing the President proceeds to the working lunch with columnists in the State Dining Room. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Sandy Berger, Mark Gearan, Mack McLarty, George Stephanopoulos, Tony Lake, Jim Hoagland, Meg Greenfeld, EJ Dionne, William Safire, Abe Rosenthal, Al Hunt,

Present include Vice President Al Gore, Warren Christopher, Leon Fuerth, Tony Lake, Larry Summers, Les Aspin, Nicholas Burns, and Strobe Talbott, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with Bob Woodward. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton pose with White House photographer Sharon Farmer. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests present for the Western States reception. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Loretta Avent and her family at the White House. Photographs from January 6, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton prepares to depart for Hot Springs, Arkansas. The President speaks with Mack McLarty and Stephanie Streett in the Outer Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton speaks with Marsha Scott and Ricki Seidman. The President and First Lady converse with staff prior to the President leaving the White House. The President embarks upon Marine One en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President departs for Hot Springs, AR. Upon arrival, the President greets Bev Lindsey Photographs from January 7, 1994 are as follows: Tony Lake meets with foreign journalists at the White House Socks the cat is photographed around the White House, including the Oval Office, Outer Oval Office, and with Debi Schiff and Rudy Moy in the West Wing. Photographs from January 8, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton departs Hope Municipal Airport en route Hot Springs. The President proceeds to Air Force One with Kevin Varney. The President embarks Air Force One en route Brussels, Belgium. The President speaks with a film crew for 'Nightline.' Present on Air Force One include Dee Dee Myers, David Gergen, Tony Lake, Mack McLarty, and Mickey Kantor, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Zaventem National Airport in Brussels, Belgium. Present includes Prime Minister Jean-Luc Dehaene, Vice Prime Minister Willy Claes, Myriam Roelants, Carlos Dewever, Warren Christopher, and Molly Raiser, among others. Scenic Photographs of Brussels, Belgium are taken by White House photographer Robert McNeely. Photographs from January 9, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Laeken Castle in Brussels. The President meets with King Albert II of Belgium. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the American embassy community at the Conrad Hotel in Brussels, Belgium. Present include Alan Blinken, Stuart Eizenstat, Robert Pearson, Earl Wayne, and Mayor of Dinant Antoine Tixhon, among others. President William

Jefferson Clinton delivers remarks to youth in the Gothic Room at the Hotel de Ville at Grand Place, Brussels, Belgium. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
