## **Summary**

FOIA 2020-0566-F is a request for all audio-visual materials relating to the President's Committee of Advisors on Science and Technology (PCAST). PCAST is a council that advises the President of the United States on science and technology and is part of the Office of Science and Technology. President Clinton established PCAST by Executive Order 12882.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2020-0566-F is a request for all audio-visual materials relating to the President's Committee of Advisors on Science and Technology (PCAST). PCAST is a council that advises the President of the United States on science and technology and is part of the Office of Science and Technology. President Clinton established PCAST by Executive Order 12882. Records processed responsive to the case include photographs of President William Jefferson Clinton meeting with the Science & Technology advisory group at the White House on July 11, 1995 and meeting with members of PCAST on June 9, 1997. Video records processed include a photo opportunity with the 2000 National Medals of Science and Technology award winners and PCAST on December 1, 2000. Other records were processed in this collection as a matter of consequence. They include photographs containing a meeting with members of the Black Caucus on July 11, 1995, a statement on Vietnam on July 11, 1995, and the President and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., receiving a report on bioethics. Video records processed include an intern group shot at the White House, departure via Marine One from the White House, a photo opportunity with Russian Deputy Foreign Minister Georgiy Enverovich Namedov, and the President viewing holiday decorations with White House volunteers on the week of November 26

through December 2, 2000. Individuals present at the events include Vice President Gore, Jack Gibbons (Co-Chair of PCAST), John Podesta, and Neal Lane, among others. 2000 National Medals of Science and Technology award winners include Gary Becker, Nancy Anderasen, Peter H. Raven, Carl R. Woese, John D. Baldeschwieler, Ralph F. Hirschmann, Yuan-Cheng G. Fung, John Griggs Thompson, Karen K Uhlenbeck, Willis E. Lamb, Jeremiah P. Ostriker, Gilbert F. White, Douglas C. Engelbart, Dean Kamen, Donald B. Beck, Robert D. Maurer, and Peter C. Schultz. Material responsive to this case was processed in FOIA case numbers 2006-1135-F and 2008-0666-F.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collections and two series, Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein - Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration, and Clinton Presidential Records: Video Recordings of the White House Television Office and the series therein - Video Recordings Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing was done at the folder/contact sheet level for photographs and at the individual item level for video. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity for photographs and tape run time integrity for video, it frequently results in the incidental processing of photographs and video that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
