Summary

The collection includes records related to Admiral Jay Johnson and the crises in the former Yugoslavia. It contains an email with a compilation of articles from U.S. news organizations regarding the NATO air strikes in Kosovo. One of these articles references the views of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, including Admiral Johnson as the Chief of Naval Operations.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-0883-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection consists of records related to Admiral Jay Johnson and the crisis in the former Yugoslavia. Admiral Johnson served as the 26th Chief of Naval Operations from 1996 to 2000 and was involved in NATO Operation Allied Force in 1999. Records responsive to this FOIA case include a National Security Council email that contains a compilation of articles from major U.S. news organizations regarding the Kosovo air strikes. The first article includes the views of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, including Admiral Johnson. The cables processed in response to this FOIA case are closed for national security reasons.
