Summary

This collection includes records related to communications between the White House and Secretary of State Madeleine Albright in 1998 and 1999 regarding the war in Kosovo. It includes State Department cables regarding the formation of a monitoring group and task force to address the conflict, as well as travel arrangements and briefing materials for President Clinton and Secretary Albright from the NSC Records Management System files.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0098-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This FOIA case contains records regarding communications between the White House and Secretary of State Madeleine Albright in 1998 and 1999 related to Kosovo. The collection includes State Department cables regarding the formation of a monitoring group and task force to address the ongoing conflict. The NSC Records Management System files contain travel arrangements and briefing materials for travel to the region on the part of Secretary Albright and President Clinton, as well as Presidential memos directing the Secretary on matters related to Kosovar refugee admissions and the UN War Crimes Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia.
