**Summary**

This collection includes Ambassador Richard Schifter's files concerning Ukraine from his time serving in the Counselor's Office on the National Security Council. It contains briefing materials for a meeting on November 22, 1994 between President Clinton and Ukrainian President Leonid Kuchma. The collection also includes a letter from David Roth, Director of Project Ukraine and the American Jewish Committee with diplomacy suggestions.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2020-0266-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains Richard Schifter's files concerning Ukraine. Mr. Schifter was an Austrian-American attorney who had served in various roles in the State Department under President Reagan and the first President Bush. President Clinton appointed Ambassador Schifter to the National Security Council, where he served in the Counselor's Office until 1997. Ambassador Schifter's files contain briefing materials for a meeting between President Clinton and Ukrainian President Leonid Kuchma on November 22, 1994, including a briefing paper, talking points, suggested press points, draft remarks, and the schedule for the state visit. The files include a letter from David Roth, Director of Project Ukraine and the American Jewish Committee, with diplomacy suggestions.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in this collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
