Summary

This collection consists of W. Bowman “Bo” Cutter’s files on International Financial Institutions. Mr. Cutter served on the National Economic Council from 1993 to 1996. The files contain papers, talking points, and other materials regarding global markets, the International Development Association, and the 1995 G-7 Summit in Halifax.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0279-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains records from the files of W. Bowman “Bo” Cutter regarding International Financial Institutions. Mr. Cutter served on the National Economic Council from 1993 to 1996. The files contain a copy of the Communique from the 1995 G-7 Summit in Halifax, a May 1995 paper and talking points in support of U.S. funding for the International Development Association, and materials from the Department of the Treasury regarding global markets stability. Many of the records related to this FOIA case are closed for national security reasons.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in this collection area—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 U.S.C. Chapter 1) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.
