

## **Extent**

Approximately 909 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

## **Summary**

The photographs processed in this segment were created on July 28, 1994. The White House photographers assigned to follow the President on this day include Sharon Farmer, Ralph Alswang, Bob McNeely, and Barbara Kinney. The case contains photographs pertaining to meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the date processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2022-0199-F is a request for all photographs taken on July 28, 1994, by White House photographers. The photographers assigned to follow the President on this day include Ralph Alswang, Sharon Farmer, Bob McNeely, and Barbara Kinney. Photographers would turn in their daily rolls to the White House Photograph Office for processing and roll number assignment, meaning while images are roughly in chronological order to how they were taken some minor discrepancies will be present depending on what order the material was turned in. FOIA processing for this case will maintain the integrity of the roll numbers assigned. Photographs processed for July 28, are as follows: Key events responsive to this case include President Clinton jogging on the National Mall in Washington, DC, meeting in the Oval Office with Chief Executive Officers regarding health care, meeting in the Oval Office with Jonathan Prince, Rahm Emanuel, Bruce Reed and George Stephanopoulos regarding his upcoming speech on the Crime Bill, addressing an event at the Department of Justice in support of the Crime Bill, Tony Lake greeting departing National Security Council staff in the West Wing, Hillary Rodham Clinton meeting with Senators and discussing strategy for health care reform on Capitol Hill in

Washington, DC, Betty Currie posing for a photo with an unidentified woman in the Oval Office, meeting with NonGovernmental Organizations in support of U.S. efforts in Rwanda, meeting in the Oval Office with Don Baer, Carter Wilkie, Leon Panetta and Lissa Muscatine regarding an upcoming speech, meeting with Vice President Albert Gore, Eli Segal and his family in the Oval Office, greeting Kristine Gebbie in the Oval Office, greeting Mr. and Mrs. Robert Pineda in the Oval Office, conferring in the Oval Office with media advisers including: Paul Begala, Stan Greenberg, Mandy Grunwald and Don Baer, Hillary Rodham Clinton talking with James Carville, Vice President Albert Gore, Tipper Gore, Jack Quinn and others in the Oval Office, President Clinton talking alone with James Carville in the hallway outside the Oval Office, talking with Nancy Hernreich in the Oval Office, meeting with Senator Bill Bradley in the Oval Office, greeting Mr. and Mrs. Gary Campbell in the Oval Office and greeting Martha Whetstone in the Oval Office. An event from a processed responsive photo contact sheet is dated July 27, 1994. The following event was reviewed: President Clinton meeting in the Oval Office with Senator George Mitchell, Vice President Albert Gore, Pat Griffin, Leon Panetta, and Ira Magaziner on July 27, 1994. ## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
