Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created on March 24, 1994. The White House photographers assigned to follow the President on this day include Robert McNeely, Sharon Farmer, Ralph Alswang, and Barbara Kinney. The case contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the date processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2022-0193-F is a request for all photographs taken on March 24, 1994, by White House photographers. The photographers assigned to follow the President on this day include Robert McNeely, Sharon Farmer, Ralph Alswang, and Barbara Kinney. Photographers would turn in their daily rolls to the White House Photograph Office for processing and roll number assignment, meaning while images are roughly in chronological order to how they were taken some minor discrepancies will be present depending on what order the material was turned in. FOIA processing for this case will maintain the integrity of the roll numbers assigned. Key events responsive to this case include a Conference of Presidents of Jewish organizations at the White House, briefings with staff in the Oval Office and Cabinet Rooms of the White House, greeting various individuals and groups in the Oval Office of the White House including Easter Seals & departing Presidential Protection Division staff, a press conference in the East Room of the White House, a meeting with the Senate Democratic Policy Committee & a Democratic Study Group on Capitol Hill, meeting with state opinion leaders at the White House, delivering remarks to the press on the South Grounds of the White House, and interviews with People magazine, Vanity Fair, and the San Francisco Examiner. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore

records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
