Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created on April 20, 1994. The White House photographers assigned to follow the President on this day include Sharon Farmer, Ralph Alswang, and Barbara Kinney. The case contains photographs pertaining to meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the date processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2022-0194-F is a request for all photographs taken on April 20, 1994, by White House photographers. The photographers assigned to follow the President on this day include Sharon Farmer, Ralph Alswang, and Barbara Kinney. Photographers would turn in their daily rolls to the White House Photograph Office for processing and roll number assignment, meaning while images are roughly in chronological order to how they were taken some minor discrepancies will be present depending on what order the material was turned in. FOIA processing for this case will maintain the integrity of the roll numbers assigned. Key events responsive to this case include an event with 1994 Boston Marathon Winners, Chancellor Franz Vranitzky of Austria visiting the White House, greeting representatives of the Arkansas State Library at the White House, Immunization Week Event in the Rose Garden of the White House, National Service event on the South Lawn of the White House, meeting regarding China in the Oval Office of the White House, congressional meeting on China in the Cabinet Room of the White House, meeting regarding Bosnia in the Cabinet Room & Oval Office of the White House, delivering remarks regarding Bosnia in the Press Briefing Room of the White House, participating in an interview at the White House regarding South Africa, taping a video at the White House for the United Methodist

Church, Addressing the Communications Workers of America national legislative political conference at the Hyatt Regency in Washington, DC, phone calls with President Boris Yeltsin, Prime Minister Jean Chretien, and Prime Minister Francois Mitterrand in the Oval Office of the White House, and addressing the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee and Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee dinner at the Washington Hilton Hotel in Washington, DC.
