Summary

This researcher submitted a FOIA request for records concerning Stockton, California. The following terms were used to conduct the search: "Stockton, CA" and "Stockton, California." Records to be opened include correspondence, invitations, maps, contracts, agency weekly reports, newsletters, news digests, listservs, press clippings, reports, and internal memoranda.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-1021-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The researcher requested all records concerning Stockton, California. Materials responsive to this FOIA request include contracts, press, press clippings, press releases, press briefings, internal memoranda, agency weekly reports, correspondence from the public, internal correspondence, listservs, news digests and clips, economic development reports, timelines, schedules, and maps. Topics include but are not limited to business interests and the workforce, drug prevention, land use issues such as with the local floodplain, and water rights conflicts. All records mentioning Stockton, California were deemed responsive; therefore, there is little thematic cohesion among the responsive materials.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) General Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Alpha Project, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM (OP), Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Various Offices, Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files, Clinton Presidential Records: ARMS Emails and Clinton Presidential Records: TRP Emails. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 - 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM, WHORM Counsel, WHORM (CL), WHORM (OP), WHORM (Too Late); WHORM (Various Offices); and WHORM (Alpha Project) series. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) was a database that contained email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system held, and allowed access to, unclassified Presidential email. The ARMS database was comprised of seven sub-series of email records called "buckets." The buckets generally represented a specific White House office. The buckets were titled: NPR for National Performance Review, NSC for National Security Council, OPD for Office of Policy Development, POTUS for President of the United States, WHO for White House Office, CEA for Council of Economic Advisers, and Default for emails not associated with an office. The Tape Restoration Project (TRP) is a database consisting of restored emails from the Automated Records Management System (ARMS) from July 1994 through June of 2000. The TRP is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential record email. The TRP database was

comprised of the same seven sub-series of email as in ARMS. NSC TRP email are arranged by topic, thereunder by bucket, and there-under chronologically by creation date. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
