## **Summary**

This collection contains records related to Victoria Nuland and the former Yugoslavia. This collection consists of records from the National Security Council's Cable, Email, and Records Management System. The collection dates from October 1998 to December 2000.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2019-0901-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The researcher submitted a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records related to Victoria Nuland and the former Yugoslavia. Specifically, the researcher requested a subject line search using the terms: Kosovo, Kosovo Liberation Army, Macedonia, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Yugoslavia, Serbia, Serbia-Montenegro, NLA, National Liberation Army, Ali Ahmeti, Skopje, Southern Serbia, Presevo Valley, and UCPMB. Records opened in this collection are an email related to Russian humanitarian aid and the situation in Montenegro. Records to be opened are from the National Security Council's Cable, Email, and Records Management System. The collection dates from October 1998 to December 2000. After a brief period in the public sector, career diplomat Victoria Nuland returned to the U.S. Department of State and is currently the Under Secretary of State for Political Affairs taking office in May 2021. During the administration of President Barack Obama, Nuland was Spokesperson for the U.S. Department of State and then the Assistant Secretary of State for European and Eurasian Affairs. Previously Nuland was United States Permanent Representative to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and foreign policy advisor to Vice President Dick Cheney. From 1993 to 1996 Ambassador Nuland was Chief of Staff for Deputy Secretary of State

Strobe Talbott. She left her position with Talbott in 1996 to become the Deputy to the Ambassador-at-Large for the Newly Independent States of the Former Soviet Union. She held foreign service positions in Russia, Mongolia, and China. Nuland is a graduate of Brown University. A significant number of records in this collection remain closed for national security reasons.

Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
