Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created on November 5, 1994 through November 10, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 107) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on November 5, 1994 through November 10, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from November 5, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Dee Dee Myers, and Harold Ickes in the Beverly Hilton Hotel in Los Angeles, California. The President reads a document handed to him by Cisneros. The President also greets guest at the hotel. Later the President proceeds to Marine One and departs en route Anaheim. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the National Association of Realtors in Anaheim, California. Present include Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Gil Woods (President-elect; National Association of Realtors), and Robert Elrod (President; National Association of Realtors). The President greets event participants and marines present. Prior to the event the President confers with Alexis

Herman, Stephen Goodin, and Dee Dee Myers. President William Jefferson Clinton attends a Get Out The Vote rally in Oakland, California. President William Jefferson Clinton greets military personnel prior to departing Los Alamitos Naval Air Station in Los Angeles, California. Present is Senator Barbara Boxer and Stew Boxer. The President boards Air Force One. President Clinton arrives on the South Lawn of the White House on his return from California. Later the President greets Senator Charles Robb and Lynda Robb. Photographs from November 6, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton prepares for an interview with Larry King, who is also photographed. Photographs from November 7, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Bruce Lindsey, Harold Ickes, Dee Dee Myers, and Janice Enright aboard Air Force One. The President speaks on the telephone at his desk. Also photographed is First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton conversing with Ickes. President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed in Wilmington, Delaware. Also photographed is Senator Joseph Biden. Miscellaneous photographs include staff portraits of Alice Rivlin and Mark Middleton and family at the White House. Photographs from November 8, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed walking towards the Oval Office along the Colonnade. The President greets the two men, Harry Rakosky & Ken Davis, who tackled gunman Francisco Martin Duran who fired at the White House. (Photographs from November 8, 1994 continued:) President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., meet with President Martti Ahtisaari of Finland at the White House. Later the President speaks alone with Strobe Talbot and Tony Lake. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in radio interviews inside the Indian Treaty Room at the White House. Harold Ickes and Richard Strauss are also present. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address a volunteers event on the South Lawn of the White House. Prior to the event the President and First Lady converse with James Alan Dorskind and Robyn Dickey in the Red Room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Eeva Ahtisaari in the Yellow Oval Room of the White House. Afterwards President William Jefferson Clinton greets Mrs. Ahtisaari in the hallway of the Ground Floor Residence. Later the First Lady greets Alexis Herman, Capricia Marshall, and Maggie Williams. The First Lady and Williams run into Kevin O'Keefe on West Executive Avenue. John Podesta greets the First Lady in the Ground Floor Residence lobby. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a treasury health reception at the United States Treasury Department in Washington, DC. Present is Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen. President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., and

Second Lady Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore meet in the Red Room of the White House. Also present is Joan Baggett. The Clintons proceed to the East Room and address a Democratic National Committee election night reception. Carolyn Huber and Sherry Lansing are photographed at the White House. Huber holds Socks. Photographs from November 9, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a briefing at the White House for an upcoming foreign trip. Present includes Laura Tyson, Tony Lake, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Robert Rubin, Erskine Bowles, George Stephanopoulos, and Bowman Cutter, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton tapes messages for Thanksgiving Day including a message to armed forces, game opening day, a drunk driving public service announcement, goals of 1994, and the 2000 teacher forum. Present includes Leon Panetta and Pat Griffin. President William Jefferson Clinton confers with advisers regarding his upcoming press conference to address the midterm national election results. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., George Stephanopoulos, Leon Panetta, Dee Dee Myers, Harold Ickes, Mark Gearan, Don Baer, David Dreyer, and Stan Greenberg. (Photographs from November 9, 1994 continued:) President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Stan Greenberg, Joan Baggett, George Stephanopoulos, Leon Panetta, and Harold Ickes in the Oval Office of the White House regarding midterm election results. Later the President participates in an extended meeting in the Indian Treaty Room. Present include Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Dee Dee Myers, David Dreyer, Don Baer, Mark Gearan, Panetta, and Stephanopoulos. The meeting is extended to the Blue Room prior to the President proceeding to a press conference. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a press conference in the State Floor of the White House to discuss the midterm election results. Reporters ask questions following the President's remarks. Present is Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. Following the press conference the President speaks with the Vice President, Dee Dee Myers, George Stephanopoulos, Leon Panetta, Harold Ickes, and Mark Gearan in the Blue Room. The President walks along the Colonnade to the West Wing and speaks with Panetta in the entryway to the Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Second Lady Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore greet First Lady Nana Konadu Agyeman-Rawlings of Ghana and her entourage in the Diplomatic Reception Room and Yellow Room of the White House. Traditional scarves of Ghana are gifted to the First Lady and Second Lady. World War II veteran Gary Schiller looks at a White House photograph "jumbo" hanging up in the White House taken during a D-Day anniversary ceremony. Miscellaneous photographs include empty shots of the Cabinet Room at the White

House. Photographs from November 10, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets the national commander of the American Legion in the Oval Office of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., greet Patsy Fleming in the Oval Office of the White House. The President, Vice President, and Mrs. Fleming proceed to an event in the Roosevelt Room where Mrs. Fleming is announced as the new director of the Office of National AIDS Policy. Also photographed includes Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala and Carol Rasco. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address a health care reception in the East Room of the White House. The President and First lady greet guests. President William Jefferson Clinton looks at sculptures on exhibit in the Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis sculpture garden at the White House. Also present is chief usher Gary Walters. Later President Clinton greets White House guests. Photographed is Betty Currie with Socks the Cat, and Deb Coyle. President William Jefferson Clinton works on a speech at the White House. Present is Leon Panetta, Don Baer, Bob Boorstin, George Stephanopoulos, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Bowman Cutter. Later the President speaks with Tony Lake, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Roger Altman, and Cutter. The President speaks alone with Gene Sperling. (Photographs from November 10, 1994 continued:) President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with George Stephanopoulos and Thomas "Mack" McLarty in the Oval Office. The President and McLarty walk down the South Lawn sidewalk to the Presidential motorcade. Also present are Bob Boorstin and Stephen Goodin. The President proceeds to Georgetown University School of Foreign Service and delivers remarks in Gaston Hall. Present include Leo J. O'Donovan (President; Georgetown University) and Peter Krogh (Dean; Georgetown University School of Foreign Service). Prior to the event the President greets guest and is presented with a book. Following the event the President returns to the White House and reads the book gifted to him. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton hosts a luncheon for women's magazine editors in the Yellow Oval Room of the White House. Also photographed is Maggie Williams. Miscellaneous photographs include Dee Dee Myers practicing putting strokes in the Outer Oval office of the White House.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
