

## **Extent**

Approximately 2,755 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

## **Summary**

The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 108) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994, through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on November 10, 1994, through November 13, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from November 10, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in a ceremonial tulip planting with Adriaan Jacobovits de Szeged, Ambassador to the United States from the Netherlands, in the Jacqueline Kennedy Garden at the White House. The First Lady greets ceremony guests in the Red Room of the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton hosts a luncheon for women's magazine editors in the Yellow Oval Room of the White House. President Clinton addresses the Georgetown University School of Foreign Service in Gaston Hall in Washington, D.C. Photographs from November 11, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, and Secretary Jesse Brown, Department of Veteran Affairs, greet veterans at a breakfast in their honor for Veteran's Day in the Blue Room of the White House. President Clinton addresses a Veteran's Day ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia. The President participates in a

wreath laying at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Ceremony participants include Donald Sioss, National Commander for the Disabled American Veterans, Secretary Jesse Brown, and others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Wilma Vaught, Director of the Women Military Service for America Memorial, in the Map Room of the White House. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Vice President Albert Gore, Leon Panetta, Bruce Lindsey, and John Podesta. President Clinton makes a statement in the Rose Garden of the White House prior to departing for the Philippines and the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) meetings in Jakarta, Indonesia. Vice President Albert Gore, Leon Panetta, and Tony Lake stand on the White House Colonnade stairs during the President's statement. Includes views of the Press Pool in the Rose Garden. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton boards Marine One at the Pentagon landing zone. President Clinton and the First Lady depart for Andrews Air Force Base for a departure to the Philippines. Photographs from November 11, 1994, Continued: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Elmendorf Air Force Base in Anchorage, Alaska. President Clinton addresses base personnel and the people of Anchorage in Hangar One at the base. General Lawrence Boese and his wife participate in the event at the base. President Clinton is presented with an Air Force jacket at the event. President Clinton records his weekly radio address at the Anchorage Museum of Art and History. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton is present at the radio address. The Clintons greet radio address guests at the museum. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visit with people and shop at local businesses during their visit to Anchorage. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet people on the tarmac at Elmendorf Air Force Base prior to their departure. The Clintons depart Anchorage and travel to Manila, Philippines. During the flight, President Clinton meets in the Conference Room on Air Force One with Tony Lake, Sandy Berger, John Podesta, George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Bowman Cutter, and Bob Boorstin. President Clinton sits with the First Lady on a couch in a hallway aboard Air Force One. The President talks with Kelly Craighead during the flight. Photographs from November 12, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Ninoy Aquino International Airport in Manila. The Clintons arrive and greet people at their hotel in Manila. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Manila hotel personnel. President Clinton visits a U.S. business breakfast hosted by Secretary Warren Christopher at the Manila Hotel. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in an arrival ceremony at Malacañang Palace in Manila.

President Clinton reviews the troops with President Fidel Ramos of the Philippines. President Clinton and President Ramos attend a wreath laying ceremony at Rizal Monument in Manila. Photographs from November 13, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tour Corregidor Island in the Philippines with President Fidel Ramos, Amelita Martinez (wife of President Ramos), Secretary 4 Warren Christopher, and others. President Clinton greets World War II veterans. President Clinton and the First Lady visit the Pacific War Memorial, Malinta Tunnel, West Gun sites, and other points of interest. Views of Tony Lake and Dee Dee Myers on a motorcycle on the island. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at the Manila American Cemetery and Memorial in Manila. The Clintons greet officials and guests at the cemetery. President Clinton and the First Lady walk alone among the graves in the cemetery.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
