

## **Extent**

Approximately 2,496 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

## **Summary**

The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 110) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994, through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on November 12, 1994, through November 16, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from November 12, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in an arrival ceremony at Malacañang Palace in Manila. President Clinton reviews the troops with President Fidel Ramos of the Philippines. Photographs from November 13, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tour Corregidor Island in the Philippines with President Fidel Ramos, Amelita Martinez (wife of President Ramos), Secretary Warren Christopher, and others. President Clinton greets World War II veterans. President Clinton and the First Lady visit the Pacific War Memorial. Photographs from November 14, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton attends the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Leader's dinner in Assembly Hall in Jakarta, Indonesia. President Soeharto (Suharto) of Indonesia addresses the dinner. President Clinton meets with Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama of Japan at the dinner. President

Clinton greets officials and others in Assembly Hall. President Clinton arrives at Istiqlal Mosque on Jakarta. The President is met by Dr. H. Tarmizi, Ministry of Religion, and others at the mosque. President Clinton signs the guestbook. President Clinton and views Korans from various Indonesian Provinces with Dr. Tarmizi and Chief Imam Muktar Natsir. President Clinton visits the Great Prayer Hall and views a model of the mosque. President Clinton meets in the Convention Center in Jakarta with Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Mickey Kantor, Secretary Ron Brown, Charlene Barshefsky, Bowman Cutter, and others prior to meeting with President Jiang Zemin of China. President Clinton participates in a bilateral meeting with President Jiang Zemin of China at the Convention Center in Jakarta. U.S. participants include Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary Ron Brown, Mickey Kantor, Tony Lake, Sandy Berger, and Bowman Cutter. Photographs from November 15, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton arrives at Istana Bogor Palace in Jakarta. President Clinton met at the palace by President Soeharto. President Clinton and leaders representing the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) pose for the traditional group photos. The leaders wear batik printed shirts. The leaders participate in APEC sessions and tour the botanical gardens. Leaders include President Clinton, President Soeharto, Indonesia, Prime Minister Jean Chretien, Canada, President Carlos de Gotari Salinas, Mexico, President Eduardo Ruis-Tagle Frei, Chile, Prime Minister Paul Keating, Australia, Prime Minister James Bolger, New Zealand, President Kim Young Sam, Korea, Prime Minister Tomichi Murayama, Japan, President Jiang Zemin, China, Vincent Siew, Taiwan, President Fidel Ramos, Philippines, Prime Minister Chuan Likphai, Thailand, Prime Minister Goh Chok Tong, Singapore, Prime Minister Mahathir Bin Mohamad, Malaysia, Sultan Bolkiah Hassanal, Brunei, Prime Minister Julius Chan, Papua New Guinea, and others. President Soeharto addresses the press regarding the APEC meetings. \* First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks with Peggy Barry and others during her flight from Jakarta to Yogyakarta, Indonesia. The First Lady arrives at the airport in Yogyakarta, Indonesia and greets people on the tarmac. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits Taman Agung Village Health Center in Yogyakarta. The First Lady is accompanied by Peggy Barry. The First Lady helps administer medicine to a baby at the health center. The First Lady greets and talks to people during her visit to the health center. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits Borbudur Temple in Yogyakarta. Capricia Marshall, Lisa Caputo, and Barbara Kinney join the First Lady. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits the palace of Sultan Hamengku Buwono X with Queen Kangeng Ratu Hemas in Yogyakarta. The First Lady watches a

performance of dancers in traditional costumes, and she observes Indonesian crafts. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits Prambanan Temple in Yogyakarta with Peggy Barry. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits Barbarsari Elementary School in Yogyakarta. The First Lady is presented with a bouquet of flowers and visits with children in their classrooms. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people at the airport prior to departing Yogyakarta for a flight to Jakarta. The First Lady arrives in Jakarta and greets people on the tarmac. President Clinton plays solitaire while seated at a table with Secretary Warren Christopher, Sandy Berger, George Stephanopoulos, and Tony Lake at the Hilton Hotel in Jakarta. Photographs from November 15, 1994, Continued: President Clinton participates in a press conference at the Hilton Hotel in Jakarta. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton have dinner at the Oasis Restaurant in Jakarta. The Clintons greet restaurant personnel. \*APEC meeting leaders seating arrangement chart was included in the photo contact sheets for this segment Photographs from November 16, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive to the Hilton Hotel in Jakarta. President Clinton visits a golf driving range in Jakarta. The President hits golf balls at the range. President Clinton goes jogging on a stadium track in Jakarta. President Clinton works alone at a table in the Presidential Suite at the Hilton Hotel in Jakarta. While in his suite, President Clinton talks with Bruce Lindsey, Sylvia Mathews, and John Podesta while tying his tie, President Clinton meets with Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Bowman Cutter, and others, and President Clinton confers with Dee Dee Myers, John Podesta, and Bruce Lindsey. President Clinton arrives at Kalibata National Heroes Cemetery in Jakarta. The President is met at the cemetery by Major General Hendro Priyono, Jakarta Area Garrison Commander. President Clinton participates in a wreath laying ceremony. President Clinton participates in a one-on-one meeting with President Soeharto at Istana Merdeka Palace in Jakarta. Secretary Warren Christopher and Tony Lake are present at the meeting. President Clinton and President Soeharto participate in an expanded meeting in palace's Jepara Room. Meeting participants include Secretary Ron Brown, Sandy Berger, Bowman Cutter, Winston Lord, and Ambassador Robert Barry. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Istana Merdeka Palace and are met by President Soeharto, his wife Siti Hartinah. Vice President Try Sutrisno, and others. The Clintons participate in an arrival ceremony at the palace. The Clintons greet members of the U.S. delegation at the palace. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates on a tour of the palace with Siti Hartinah.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
