Fauci has served as the director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases since 1984 and has acted as an advisor to every U.S. President since Ronald Reagan. He serves as Chief Medical Advisor to President Joe Biden and is one of the lead members of the White House COVID-19 Response Team.

The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 - 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM, WHORM Counsel, WHORM (CL), WHORM (OP), WHORM (Too Late); WHORM (Various Offices); and WHORM (Alpha Project) series. FOIA 2020-0518-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: PR005-01 Photographs Granted, Presidential.
