Summary

This collection contains a copy of Justice Blackmun's letter to President Clinton informing the President of his intent to retire. Justice Harry Blackmun served as an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States from 1970 until his retirement in 1994, and is best known as the author of the Supreme Court's opinion in the abortion rights case, *Roe v. Wade*.

The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 – 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM, WHORM Counsel, WHORM (CL), WHORM (OP), WHORM (Too Late); WHORM (Various Offices); and WHORM (Alpha Project) series. FOIA 2020-0439-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: FG051 Supreme Court of the United States.
