Summary

This collection consists of records related to conversations and meetings between President Clinton and European Commission (EC) President Jacques Santer from 1995 to 1999. It includes a memcon from a December 1995 meeting between President Clinton, President Santer, and Spanish Prime Minister Felipe Gonzalez in Madrid, as well as a copy of the 1997 Joint President/Commission Aide Memoire regarding European Union (EU) Policies and Measures in Regard to Iran and Libya.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2021-0244-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains materials related to conversations and meetings between President Clinton and European Commission (EC) President Jacques Santer. The European Commission is the executive branch of the European Union, and Mr. Santer served as the President from 1995 to 1999. During this period, the United States engaged with the EU on a number of matters, including trade, human rights, and international security. The records release in response to this FOIA request include a previously declassified December 3, 1995 memcon of a meeting between President Clinton, President Santer, and Prime Minister Felipe Gonzalez of Spain in Madrid, as well as transmittal memos and forms for other memcons that remain classified. There is also a copy of the 1997 Joint President/Commission Aide Memoire regarding EU Policies and Measures in Regard to Iran and Libya. The majority of the records related to this FOIA case are closed for national security reasons.
